

# From Static Planning to Real-Time Decision Intelligence

The transition from Static Planning to Real-Time Decision Intelligence marks the final collapse of the "Annual Budget" as a viable business tool. In a market defined by 24/7 volatility, waiting for a quarterly review to shift capital is now considered a form of professional negligence. For Fortis & Peak, this represents the move to Integrated Business Planning (IBP) 2.0, where financial models are living, breathing digital twins of the enterprise.

# The Death of the "Fixed Budget"

As of March 2026, the traditional 12-month budget has been replaced by Rolling Monthly Planning. Instead of a static document created in October and ignored by April, firms now use a **Perpetual 18-Month Window**—as one month ends, a new one is added to the horizon.

Planning has shifted from "line-item guessing" to **Driver-Based Forecasting**. AI agents monitor the core drivers of your business—such as the spot price of lithium, regional labor availability, or real-time consumer sentiment—and automatically adjust the financial outlook the moment those drivers shift.

## The 2026 CFO

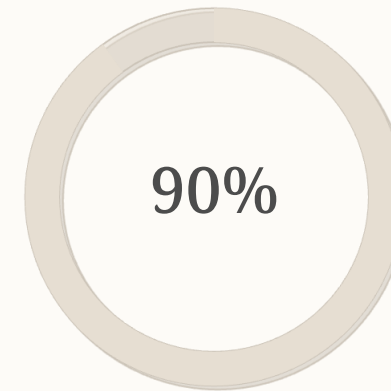

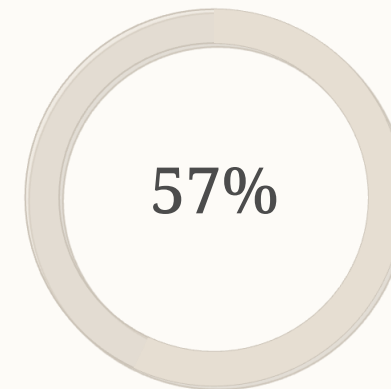
