Complete, live transparency across operations, finance, and customer activity – no blind spots, no lag.

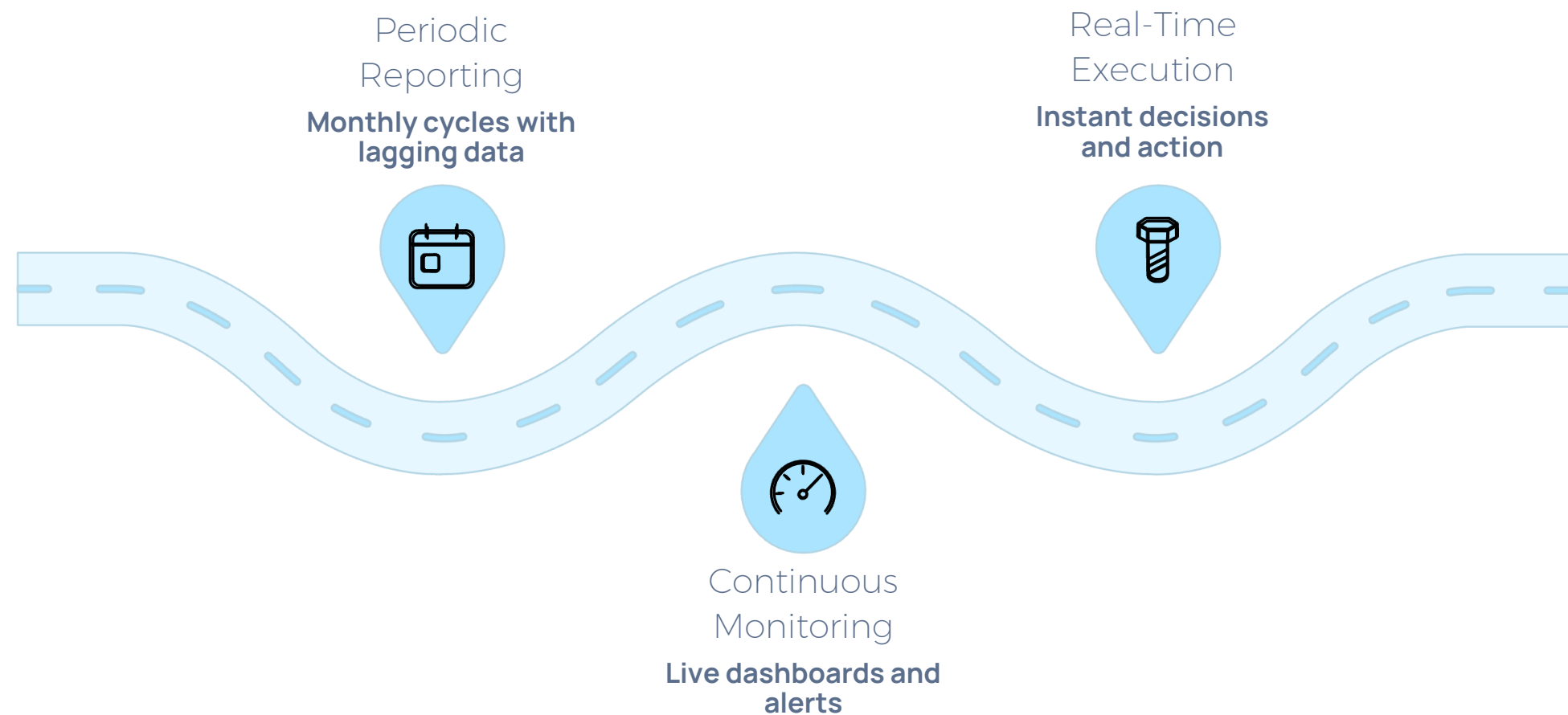


Responsiveness
