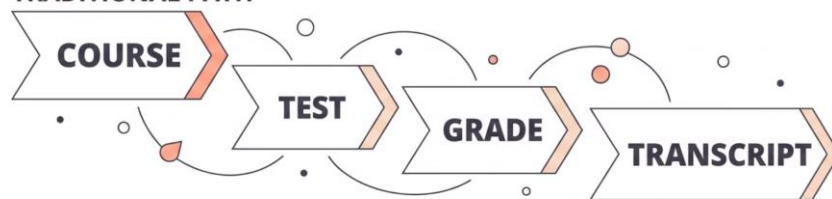

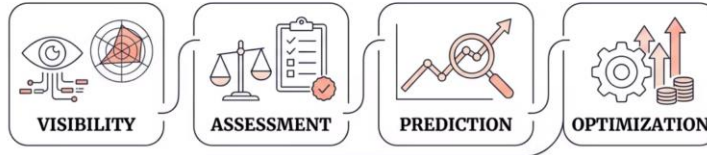

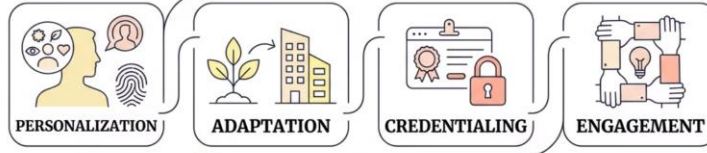
3D&S Framework

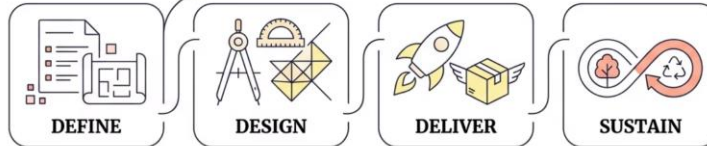
Intelligence Layer - FortisIntel
